

Barker's Landing Tennis Courts
Rules and Guidelines
For Tennis Instructors

The purpose of the following rules and guidelines is to provide a uniform policy for use of the Barker's Landing tennis courts by tennis instructors who are giving lessons to Barker's Landing residents.

1. Courts are for use by Barker's Landing residents and their guests only. Tennis instructors are considered guests of the resident who is taking the lesson. Residents must accompany guests at all times and have current membership identification tags. Residents who contract for tennis lessons in Barker's Landing courts are responsible for verifying liability insurance of coach, signing up for court in accordance with neighborhood rules and seeing that coach observes the same rules as all other guests.
2. Residents must reserve a court for a tennis lesson. One resident may reserve one court. Courts 1, 2 and 3 may be reserved for 90 minutes. Residents may sign up at the tennis courts no earlier than 7:00 p.m. two days prior to the lesson. For example, to reserve a court at 9:00 a.m. Thursday, residents may sign up at 7:00 p.m. Tuesday and not before.
3. Court 4 is a "walk-on" court and is available on a first-come, first-serve basis only. Play is limited to one hour if players are waiting.
4. When more than one court has been reserved by more than one resident for tennis lessons, these courts should be adjacent to each other whenever possible to avoid interfering with play on other courts.
5. Tennis etiquette dictates that if more than 3 balls are in use on a court, this should not interfere with play on other courts.
6. An effort should be made to schedule all lessons during non-peak usage times.

7. General rules of tennis etiquette are required of all children taking lessons on the courts. It is the responsibility of the tennis instructor to enforce these rules.
8. Proper tennis attire, including non-marking tennis shoes, must be worn at all times by tennis instructors and residents.
9. No glass, pets, skateboards, bikes, roller blades, etc., are allowed on the tennis courts. All litter must be placed in the trashcans before leaving the courts.
10. If the squeegees are used during the lesson, they should be returned to the hooks in the restroom when the lesson is finished.
11. The gates are to be locked when leaving the courts.
12. A complete set of rules governing use of the courts is posted on the bulletin board next to the courts and is also published at the front of the Barker's Landing Telephone Directory.
